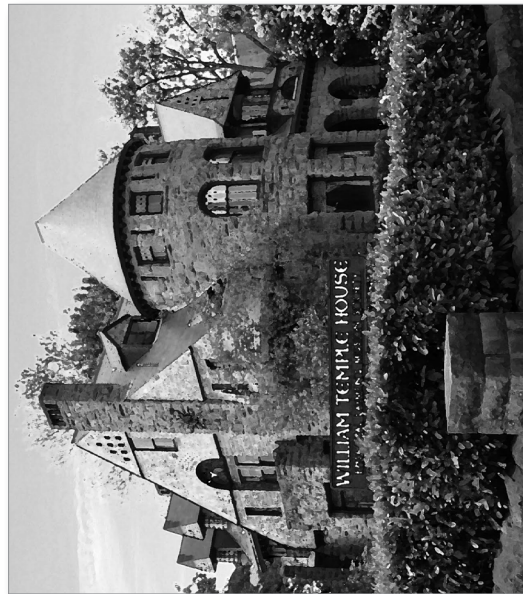

Mental Health Counseling

William Temple House provides low-cost, professional mental health counseling to individuals, couples and families who do not have health insurance, are not covered by government health programs, and cannot afford fees typically charged by private agencies.



For many working poor individuals and families in the Portland area William Temple House is the only resource for professional mental health counseling.

Group programs and classes are available during the year. Topics vary but have included coping with unemployment; managing conflict; building closeness and intimacy; positive thinking for moderately depressed people; and building self-confidence for teens who have been bullied.

Counseling sessions and group classes are provided for a sliding scale fee however, no one is turned away for inability to pay.

William Temple House emphasizes high-

quality professional counseling treatment, respect and open access.

Social Services

William Temple House heals the whole person and an important part of our holistic approach is meeting immediate needs for food and clothing.

Our food pantry is an emergency resource for individuals and families. We also work with clients to find permanent solutions so that they do not become dependent on assistance.

The William Temple House Children's Clothing Closet provides new clothing to schoolchildren in need. On a case-by-case basis we distribute vouchers to our Thrift Store to adults who need clothing.

William Temple House also provides hygiene products, emergency dental care, housing necessities, psychotropic prescription drug vouchers, public transportation vouchers, and other assistance as resources allow.

William Temple House partners with a variety of social service providers and we often provide referrals to other resources in the community when we are not able to meet a specific need.

Pastoral Care

People of all beliefs and backgrounds are welcome to receive spiritual support and counseling at William Temple House.

Spiritual support is an important component of William Temple House's holistic approach because a crisis of faith often accompanies a financial or psychological crisis.

Thrift Store

The William Temple House Thrift Store is popular with shoppers looking for low-cost furniture, household goods and clothes and with those who prefer to recycle and reuse rather than buy new. Store proceeds support counseling and emergency social services for the poor.

We welcome donations of furniture, household goods, books, antiques, collectibles and clothes that are clean and in good working order. Donations may be dropped off at the store during business hours. Pickup service is available for furniture and other large donations. Call 503.222.3328 for more information.
